Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project – P 400450226 – St. Clair Avenue & East 49th Street Vault Replacement (City of Cleveland - Ward 10)

CLEVELAND – On Wednesday April 17, 2024, Dominion Energy Ohio's gas pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- East 47th Street Southeast corner of St Clair Avenue and East 47th Street
- East 49th Street Northwest corner of St Clair Avenue and East 49th Street

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. As well as removing old underground vaults and the replacement with new. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. The work on the project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in May 2024. Permanent restorations will be completed by June 2024.
