OBTAINING A FAIR LOAN:

Understand... Get a copy of your credit score. This will help to secure a lower interest loan.

Don't Rush... Get at least three detailed written quotes and consult an attorney before signing a contract.

Never sign... Any loan documents that are not completely filled out and always ask for copies of signed documents. In most cases, a home loan can be cancelled within three business days of signing (including Saturdays).

LOAN PROGRAMS:

Cleveland Restoration Society: Helps owners of historic homes with maintenance, improvements, and preservation issues. Call 216-426-1000.

Housing Enhancement Loan Program (HELP): A low interest loan administered by Cuyahoga County and is available through the participating lender. For more information, call 216-443-2149.

Neighborhood Housing Services: A low interest loan available for occupied one to four unit dwellings. Call 216-458-4663.

Credit, Foreclosure and Housing Counselors: Dial 211 (First Call For Help) or 216-436-2000 and the staff will direct you to a non-profit agency for counseling assistance.
