Ambler Street Bridge Repair Project

Between Woodhill Road and Holton Avenue
(City of Cleveland - Ward 3)

CLEVELAND – Beginning Oct. 8, 2018, Ambler Street will be closed between Woodhill Road to Holton Avenue to allow Cuyahoga County to perform bridge repairs. Work will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Detour signs will be posted along Woodhill and Buckeye roads.
