Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update
Monday, September 18, 2017, Dominion East Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure
Replacement Project – PIR's 2135 & 2117
Idarose Avenue & E. 143rd Street
(City of Cleveland Ward 10)

CLEVELAND – Pipeline infrastructure improvements begin on Monday, September 18, 2017 and include work on the following streets:

PIR 2135

- Idarose Avenue – From Hayden Avenue to Coit Road
- Castalia Avenue – From Hayden Avenue to E. 145th Street
- Glenside Road – From Hayden Avenue to E. 143rd Street
- Hayden Avenue – From St. Clair Avenue to Glenside Road
- E. 140th Street – From St. Clair Avenue to Idarose Avenue
- E. 141st Street – From St. Clair Avenue to Idarose Avenue
- E. 143rd Street – From Glenside Road to Woodworth Avenue
- E. 144th Street – From Coit Road to Idarose Avenue
- E. 145th Street – From Coit road to Woodworth Avenue

- E. 143rd Street – From Coit Road to Idarose Avenue

The project scope is to replace the old steel mainline with new plastic mainline in the sidewalk area. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times on two lane side streets with traffic control personnel in the work zone(s) directing traffic. On Hayden Avenue, the curb lane will be occupied. One lane of traffic flow in each direction will be maintained. A Law Enforcement Officer (L.E.O.) will be present at all signalized intersections. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction and the work will take place Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in the spring of 2018. Any sidewalk restoration not completed by winter will receive temporary 2" thick concrete until full restoration can take place in the spring of 2018.
