**Brooklawn Avenue Improvements  
Between W. 129<sup>th</sup> Street and W. 120<sup>th</sup> Street  
Monday, February 12, 2018  
(Ward 11)**

**Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue**

**CLEVELAND** – Construction of the Brooklawn Avenue Culvert Replacement Project over Big Creek will commence on, weather dependent, February 12, 2018. The road will be closed to thru traffic between West 129<sup>th</sup> Street and West 120<sup>th</sup> Street for the duration of construction activities. Local access to properties adjacent to the culvert will be maintained. All adjacent driveways will be accessible during this closure.

The Brooklawn Avenue Culvert Replacement Project includes the replacement of the culvert, new concrete pavement, concrete drive apron, new curb, underdrain and walk just east and west of the culvert, the lowering of watermain, additional miscellaneous water work, and the relocation of power poles. The work will take place during daytime hours from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Work is scheduled for completion in July 2018.
